

Learning Pathways at CPH

Welcome (back) to school Career Path High! We are excited to see students on campus this year and keep everyone safe and healthy at the same time. As a Blended Model we are happy to provide 3 different pathways to provide the best fit for students to continue their education this year that will allow for any transitioning risk levels. Please read through the descriptions below to help you understand the different paths available so you can make the best choice for your student.

Distance Learning

100% Distance Learning Path is available for students who are considered high risk, live with someone who is high risk and/or their parents are not comfortable sending them to campus. In this path students will be able to participate in on campus classes streamed to their computers at home, attend virtual classes at scheduled times and are able to access virtual teacher support during the school day. Attendance will be taken through log in reports and remote class attendance. Students in this path will need to make an appointment in advance with parental written permission to be on campus.

11th & 12th Graders in Davis Tech Programs will need to follow Davis Tech's on campus and virtual class requirements and should keep those requirements in mind when selecting a program.

Blended Learning

Career Path High is a blended model! In order to ensure safe distancing and quality instruction the Blended Learning Pathway this year will provide a rotation schedule for on campus and virtual learning. The school calendar will have A/B days where specific grade level students will be assigned on campus and virtual learning days. On Campus Days will include scheduled classes for direct instruction and scheduled flex time. Virtual Learning Days will include scheduled virtual classes and virtual flex time support from teachers. Attendance will be taken on campus days through Time Station scans and on virtual days through log ins and remote class attendance. Students in this path will be able to choose to come to campus on their On Campus days and will need to work from home on their assigned virtual days.

11th & 12th Graders in Davis Tech Programs may schedule their Davis Tech Program on A or B days depending on individual need to have CPH Flex Time on Campus.

On Campus Only *

100% On Campus Path is available only for students who do not have internet access at home or other convenient location off campus to do virtual work off campus. It can also be available for students whose IEPs require all instruction to be face to face.

Attendance will be taken through Time Station scans only. Students will be expected to work on campus every day except for days when the parent excuses their absence due to acceptable excused absence reasons. Students on campus during their grade cohort's virtual day will be expected to work in the Flex area and participate in virtual class instruction.

B Days	11 th & 12 th Grade Virtual Days	9 th & 10 th Grade Virtual Days

*Career Path High will be adding space in the middle of September to allow for more students on campus and better physical distancing.

Attendance

Remember that at CPH we take attendance two ways - 1) Daily Log in - for those who are working at home and on pace. 2) Class Attendance - this can be on campus or virtual depending on your pathway selection. Students who are required to be in class whether it is a "required" day like orientation or testing days or required because they are behind and on the Student Support Pathway (SSP) will need to log attendance on TimeStation.

How to Excuse Absences -

Parents are encouraged to excuse student absences right away if they are sick and unable to fulfill their attendance requirement for the day or have any other excusable reason. The best way to excuse an absence is through the school website careerpathhigh.org. On the homepage is the "excuse absence" tab where you can quickly excuse the absence.
