Meeting Minutes

1. Welcome and roll call - 6:00
  - a. Attending: Natalie Brush, Eric Corrington, Christie Wentz, Anthony Uriona (staff), Stacey Hutchings (principal), JeAnna Jenkins-Ellis
2. Adopt Minutes from November 4, 2020
  - a. Motion to approve by Anthony Uriona. Seconded by JeAnna Jenkins-Ellis. All approved.
3. Review 2020-2021 Plan
  - a. Two goals - paraprofessionals & 10th grade curriculum design. No 2019 end of year assessments due to Covid closures. Paraprofessionals are useful especially this year. Math teacher did not return from last year. Curriculum specialist hired who was a previous CPH teacher. Used Canvas for 10th grade math due to flexibility. New math teacher was hired this year. Many barriers that prevent us from seeing the results of the goals from last year: Covid 19, students not in the classroom, new teacher who was also out for medical reasons. Data shows low completion for Q1. Using Canvas also has challenges. Too early to tell if we have success or failure in last year's plan.
4. Ideas for 2021-2022 Plan
  - a. There is not an expected funding increase. It should be the same amount as last year. Due to the challenges, the group is looking at keeping the paraprofessionals with the possibility of adding one more. Stacy also reminded us that due to the new health building at DTC there is more space for CPH. This creates additional need for help in learning centers to free up teachers. CPH is looking at renewing Odysseyware in the next few years and whether the school should use Canvas to allow the teachers more flexibility to change or update curriculum mid year. Concern is pre-tests that support competency-based education. The two options would be three paraprofessionals or 2 paraprofessionals with some funding to support additional curriculum development in another area. More discussion at the next meeting.
