Meeting Minutes

1. Welcome and roll call - 6:00
 - a. Attending: Natalie Brush, Eric Corrington, Christie Wentz, Anthony Uriona (staff).
 - b. Absent: Stacey Hutchings (principal), JeAnna Jenkins-Ellis
2. Leadership Positions Election
 - a. Eric will remain as chair, Christie will be vice-chair, and Natalie will remain as secretary. Vote was unanimous in the affirmative.
3. Review of State Land Trust website and trainings
 - a. The committee looked at the state website on land trusts. It was decided that each person would do the 2020 training on their own before the next meeting.
4. Data Review
 - a. Mr. Uriona provided a slide presentation on 2017-2018 data and 2018-2019 data for CPH and the state in English/Language Arts, Math, and Science percentages. We do not have data from 2019-2020. This is the 3rd year using Odysseyware.
 - b. The committee discussed the additional barriers to learning with the pandemic this year, the school accreditation, and the addition of Canvas for secondary math II this year. Most students are pulling away from school.
 - c. Last year's plan included two paraprofessionals which have been useful in proctoring online tests, helping with students who are working in-person, and providing support for SSP students.
 - d. End of year completion data for Q1 historically, and actual for 2020. Math is still the most difficult subject for students to complete and understand. The completion rates were over 50% which is better than many schools across the state with online learning or hybrid models of teaching. We need to recognize the good work that is being done. Also the Pass/Fail option could have helped to raise completion rates.
5. Next meeting is December 2 @ 6:00. We will be reviewing the current plan and looking for options for next year. The committee discussed whether to do another staff survey to get feedback. Natalie gave the members access to the survey from last year with the results. We can discuss any changes and whether this would be helpful to send out.
